

Orbyt Privacy Policy

Orbyt Inc. and its affiliates (“Orbyt,” “we,” “our,” and/or “us”) value the privacy of individuals who use our website and related services (collectively, our “Services”). This privacy policy (the “Privacy Policy”) explains how we collect, use, and share information from or about Orbyt users (“Users”) or their devices. By using our Services, you agree to the collection, use, disclosure, and procedures this Privacy Policy describes. Beyond the Privacy Policy, your use of our Services is also subject to our Terms of Service.

Information We Collect

We may collect a variety of information from or about you or your devices from various sources, as described below.

If you do not provide your information when requested, you may not be able to use our Services if that information is necessary to provide you with our Services or if we are legally required to collect it.

A. Information You Provide to Us.

Registration and Profile Information. When you sign up for an account, we ask you for your name, and (email address or phone number), along with any other information you elect to provide us, such as your usernames or handles on various social media services.

Third Party Information Syncing. We allow users to synchronize their data from third parties. These third parties include Google. From Google, we use data such as contact and calendar information. When you authorize access to this data, we synchronize this data from the third party and our own data stores. This is to keep your calendar and contacts on Orbyt up to date. Your data is only kept on our servers and is not accessible to any other party.

Communications. If you contact us directly, we may receive additional information about you. For example, when you contact us for support, we will receive your name, email address, phone number, the contents of your message, and other information you choose to provide.

B. Information We Collect When You Use Our Services.

Location Information. When you use our Services, if you allow us, we may receive your precise location information. We also infer your more general location information (for example, your IP address may indicate your more general geographic region).

Device Information. We receive information about the device and software you use to

access our Services, including internet protocol (IP) address, web browser type, operating system version, phone manufacturer, device identifiers, and push notification tokens.

Usage Information. To help us understand how you use our Services and to help us improve them, we automatically receive information about your interactions with our Services, like the pages or other content you view, the searches you conduct, people you follow, and the dates and times of your visits.

Your Contacts. If you permit us to access the address book on your device, we may access and store names and contact information from your address book to facilitate invitations and social interactions that you initiate through our Services and for other purposes described in this privacy policy or at the time of consent or collection. We also collect your contacts if you invite them to use our Services or share information or content with them from our Services.

Information from Cookies and Similar Technologies. If you choose to login to our Service through a third party service such as (not limited to) Google, Apple, Microsoft, Twitter, or LinkedIn, we may collect information about you from these services such as your name, email address and profile picture. We may use this information to help prevent fraud and to provide you with information about our Services.

Please review your web browser's "Help" file to learn the proper way to modify your cookie settings. Please note that if you delete or choose not to accept cookies from the Service, you may not be able to utilize the features of the Service to their fullest potential.

C. Information We Receive from Third Parties.

How We Use the Information We Collect

We use the information we collect from or about you or your devices:

- To provide, maintain, improve, and enhance our Services;
- To communicate with you, provide you with updates and other information relating to our Services, provide information that you request, respond to comments and questions, and otherwise provide customer support;
- To facilitate the connection of third party services or applications, such as social networks;
- For marketing purposes, such as developing and providing promotional and advertising materials that may be useful, relevant, valuable, or otherwise of interest to you;
- To personalize your experience on our Services such as presenting tailored content;

- To de-identify and aggregate information collected through the Services and use it for any lawful purpose.
- To find and help prevent fraud, and respond to trust and safety issues that may arise;
- For compliance purposes, including enforcing our Terms of Service or other legal rights, or as may be required by applicable laws and regulations or requested by any judicial process or governmental agency; and for other purposes for which we provide specific notice at the time the information is collected.

How We Share the Information We Collect

Affiliates. We may share any information we receive with our affiliates for any of the purposes described in this Privacy Policy.

Vendors and Service Providers. We may share any information we receive with vendors and service providers retained in connection with the provision of our Services.

Analytics Partners. We use analytics services such as Google Analytics to collect and process certain analytics data. These services may also collect information about your use of other websites, apps, and online resources. You can learn about Google's practices by going to <https://www.google.com/policies/privacy/partners/>, and opt-out of them by downloading the Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on, available at <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>.

As Required By Law and Similar Disclosures. We may access, preserve, and disclose your information if we believe doing so is required or appropriate to: (a) comply with law enforcement requests and legal process, such as a court order or subpoena; (b) respond to your requests; or (c) protect your, our, or others' rights, property, or safety. For the avoidance of doubt, the disclosure of your information may occur if you post any objectionable content on or through the Services.

Merger, Sale, or Other Asset Transfers. We may disclose and transfer your information to service providers, advisors, potential transactional partners, or other third parties in connection with the consideration, negotiation, or completion of a corporate transaction in which we are acquired by or merged with another company or we sell, liquidate, or transfer all or a portion of our business or assets.

Consent. We may also disclose information from or about you or your devices with your permission.

Your Choices

Sharing Preferences. We provide you with settings to allow you to set your sharing preferences for content you post to the Services.

Location Information. You can prevent your device from sharing precise location information at any time through your device's operating system settings.

Contacts. You may not 'disable' the sharing of contact information, but it is easy to manually ensure that your contact info is not shared: do not scan or be scanned. However, information about your contacts is core to our Services and without it you may not be able to successfully use our Services.

Marketing Communications. You can unsubscribe from our promotional emails via the link provided in the emails. Even if you opt-out of receiving promotional messages from us, you will continue to receive administrative messages from us.

Do Not Track. There is no accepted standard on how to respond to Do Not Track signals, and we do not respond to such signals.

Google Data: Calendar & Contacts. You can choose to not sync your Google calendar and contacts data with Orbyt. If you choose to sync your Google data and subsequently decide to remove your integration with Google via Orbyt, we will purge the Google data that we originally collected if you request that we do so via written correspondence to hello@orbyt.cc. Orbyt's use of information received from Google Accounts will adhere to Google API Services User Data Policy, including the Limited Use requirements. We do not transfer information from connected accounts to other apps.

If you choose not to provide us with information we collect, some features of our Services may not work as intended.

Third Parties

Our Services may contain links to other websites, products, or services that we do not own or operate. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of these third parties. Please be aware that this Privacy Policy does not apply to your activities on these third party services or any information you disclose to these third parties. We encourage you to read their privacy policies before providing any information to them.

Security

We make reasonable efforts to protect the information we collect from or about you or your devices by using physical and electronic safeguards designed to improve the security of the information we maintain. However, as our Services are hosted electronically, we can make no guarantees as to the security or privacy of such information.

Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect, maintain, or use personal information from children under

13 years of age, and no part of our Services are directed to children. If you learn that a child has provided us with personal information in violation of this Privacy Policy, please alert us via the Contact Information section, below.

International Visitors

Our Services are hosted in the United States and intended for visitors located within the United States. If you choose to use the Services from the European Union or other regions of the world with laws governing data collection and use that may differ from U.S. law, then please note that you are transferring your personal information outside of those regions to the United States for storage and processing. Also, we may transfer your data from the U.S. to other countries or regions in connection with storage and processing of data, fulfilling your requests, and operating the Services. By providing any information, including personal information, on or to the Services, you consent to such transfer, storage, and processing.
